Re: CLARIFICATION IN RELATION TO REMOVAL OF DULUX EXSULITE “KOOLTHERM” and “DIRECT FIX” CODEMARK CERTIFICATES

CMI has been directed by JAS-ANZ to withdraw and reissue the current DULUX EXSULITE “KOOLTHERM” and “DIRECT FIX” CODEMARK CERTIFICATES CodeMark certifications.

This action has been taken in response to a review of these certificates that has identified a need for clarification of content in line with changes in the Building Code and Dulux’s stated intention to limit the product to Volume 2, Class 1&10 construction .

It has been deemed appropriate that 2 (of 5) Dulux Exsulite CodeMark certificates should be withdrawn for review and reissue, because under current guidelines the originally issued system certifications allowed for consideration for use in a wider scope of construction types than would be considered today.

More specifically the scope elements impacting the change of assessment relate only to the systems potential use in future Volume 1, Class 2-9 applications and do not impact the systems potential use in Volume 2, Class 1&10 construction which will form the specific scope of new Certifications currently under review for those systems.

In summary :

The following Dulux Exsulite CodeMark Certificates have been withdrawn as 15 February, 2019 with system recertification submissions underway redefining the scope appropriately to within Volume 2, Class 1 &10 categories (covering typical residential 1-2 storey Housing)

- CM40082 Exsulite®-Kooltherm® Thermal Façade System
- CMA-CM40138 Exsulite Thermal Facade Non-Cavity System

The following Dulux Exsulite CodeMark Certificates have NOT been withdrawn :

- CM40006 Exsulite ® Thermal Façade Cavity System
- CMA-CM40057 Exsulite Composite Thermal Facade Cavity System
- CMA-CM40060 Exsulite Composite Thermal Facade Non-Cavity System
